#### **REGULATION**

The Dean of Research and Extension, Coordination of the Master in Transcultural Practices / UNIFACVEST and the Council of Teaching, Research and Extension - CONSEPE, in the use of its attributions, decides to make public the 5th INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM INNOVATIVE / UNIFACVEST, in the November 21, 2019 at the UNIVEST / UNIFACVEST THEATER at the UNIFACVEST University Center.

## 1. OBJECTIVE:

The 5th INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM OF INNOVATIVE TRANSCULTURAL PRACTICES aims to establish possible meetings, respecting points of view, providing interdisciplinary dialogical practices that enable the analysis, communication, debate, valorization and publication of innovative and transcultural activities of responsibility extension, initiation and scientific production. developed by the Doctors and Post-Doctors of the UNIFACVEST UNIVERSITY CENTER, Graduates, Graduates, Masters and Doctors and Post-Doctors, invited to the event, focusing on INNOVATIVE, municipal, state, federal and international TRANSCULTURAL PRACTICES in general and seeking in the breadth of his speech (publication) the presentation of proposals for our mountainous region.

Synthesis Category 7: Contributions to INNOVATIVE TRANSCULTURAL PRACTICES associated with the study of Psychology, Human Rights and Citizenship;

Synthesis Category 8: Contributions to INNOVATIVE CULTURAL PRACTICES associated with the study and understanding of Afro-Brazilian issues;

Synthesis Category 9: Contributions to INNOVATIVE TRANSCULTURAL PRACTICES associated with the areas of knowledge: LANGUAGES, MATHEMATICS, HUMAN SCIENCES and NATURAL SCIENCES.

### 4. MODALITIES:

The organization must strictly follow the steps below: TITLE: SUBTITLE (if any) (centered writing, capital letters, bold, larger font; Below TITLE (justified) right): Full name with footnote identification: Institution, email, course; INTRODUCTION; GOALS; METHODOLOGY; RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS; CONCLUSION; REFERENCES. It is mandatory the presence of the project's executors during the POSTER exhibition period, to provide any clarification to the Symposium participants, being organized from 8h-12h, 13h-17h and 18h-22h.
- 4.3.1 It is recommended that information is organized in columns for readability. Whenever possible, present illustrations that facilitate understanding. POSTER text should be legible at least 1m apart, with the title having a larger font than the textual content and section titles should be highlighted. The poster size should be 95cm wide and 125cm high. POSTER members must register (MODE 5 (BANNER and SUMMARY)) and remove the badge with the Event Organizer Room 28, Certificates and Badges. Accompany the lectures and tables in THEATER, workshops and communications in the indicated rooms. Group members should always be present for explanations of the Banner / Poster, stamping the entry and exit, according to their participation, in the reception of the event and follow the development of activities.
